<u>67.10 Red telephone kiosk at Coxbank</u> – Efforts to protect the phone box a few years ago led us to believe that, though it is not "listed" and cannot be repaired in the event of major damage, it will be retained. However, BT regularly undertake reviews of unprofitable phone boxes and the kiosk may be under threat again in the future. The Parish Council is asked to note that Councils can pay £1 to take over ownership of the kiosk, minus phone equipment. Alternatively, councils can pay an annual fee of £500 to keep a phone inside the box, about half the cost faced by BT.
