USE OF THE BUTTER MARKET POLICY

- The Butter Market is available for use by registered charities and not for profit organisations, those working directly within the community of Audlem being given preference.
- 2. Under normal circumstances, use is limited to 2 hours, normally between 10am and 12 noon on Saturdays, however other times can be accommodated. *
- 3. Normally, any group would not be eligible to more than 2 sessions in any 12 month period. *
- 4. If selling food products or produce, applicants must satisfy the requirements of Cheshire East Environmental Health. Further information can be found at:

- 5. Evidence of Public Liability Insurance must be provided to the Parish Clerk.
- 6. A disclaimer may be required to be signed in advance of any agreed usage.
- 7. It is the applicant's responsibility to get in touch with St James' Church to ensure that their proposed usage does not clash with any scheduled weddings, etc.

*Exceptions to points 2 and 3 would include use of the Butter Market when no items are on sale such as a rallying point for community events or community information stalls.

- ✓ Contact information
- ✓ Date required
- ✓ Time required
- ✓ Nature of the stall, with specific information of any products to be sold e.g. community information point, raffle ticket selling, selling food produce, selling charity fundraising products, cake stall
- ✓ Confirmation that St James' Church has been consulted.
- ✓ PLUS: Evidence of public liability insurance (electronic)
