1. Grassland and hedges See TF Mowing / hedge cutting plan agreed with Tony Seabridge TS

2. Area 1a Plant some shrubs in between New Trees (ref map) to give ground cover for wildlife **Done**

3. Area 2 (Edge) Briars cut back; Plant 4-6 shrubs so as to shield view of ME's garden and house **Done**

4. Area 2 Lower (Edge)

Briars have been cut back by app 3 metres enabling footpath to be much lower, such that walkers eye level will be below ME's garden. Plant a field maple supplied by PM Done. To be flailed again in Autumn along with Area 7 from bridge to lock gate.

5. Area 3 (Edge) Area 5 (Boggy Land) Cut stems on ivy overgrown on trees our side of the boundary and on bank of stream in lower field **Done**

8. Area 8 (between pond and mound in upper field)

Rotavate in preparation for wild flower seeding (seeds to be supplied by Chris Lewis) **PM will Roundup area to remove thistles and prepare ground for sowing Done. Agreed to sow soon using local wild flower seeds**

9. Bridge

Wire netting and metal rods being pulled down by rabbits; referred to CRT, response awaited **SE**

Spray alder sapling new growth in May significant **new growth not appearing yet; may delay till autumn**
