PUBLIC FORUM – No members of the public were present.

- 6.160 <u>APOLOGIES</u> Apologies were accepted from Cllr Mrs Down, Cllr Mrs Seddon, Cllr Mrs Christie and Cllr Consterdine.
- 6.161 <u>DECLARATION OF INTERESTS</u> CIIr Mrs Stockton declared an interest in Agenda Item No 165.1 Planning application P07/0303.

6.162 CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES

The minutes of the meeting held on 5th March were approved and signed as a correct record of the meeting.

6.163 PARISH AFFAIRS

<u>163.1 Village policing/antisocial behaviour</u> – PC Maple reported on two recent incidents involving fires. CCTV pictures were being widely circulated.

163.2 Youth Council – The Chairman reported that 5 young people had met with representatives of the Parish Council on 12th March. As a result, Brine Leas School was being asked to provide an opportunity for Councillors to make a presentation to Audlem children during a "Citizenship" lesson. Additional information had been obtained from the South Petherton Youth Council, and arrangements had been made from the Chairman, Cllr Stretch, Cllr Mrs Down and Cllr Hill to meet with Cllr Eric Beak of Malpas Parish Council.

163.3 Ambulance response times – At the time there was nothing to report on local issues.
163.4 Fencing at children's playground – There was a discrepancy between the recollections of those present at the meeting on13th February. Councillors and residents had understood that CNBC were prepared to replace the post & wire fence or provide hedging on the fence line, whereas the Environmental Services Manager had written to say that this was not the case. One of the residents involved had indicated that they would like the post & wire fence reinstated.

Resolved: that CNBC be requested to reinstate the post & wire fence.

<u>163.5 CNBC "brown bin" scheme</u> – It was noted that the scheme would be extended to rural areas by June.

<u>163.6 Annual Village Meeting</u> – The Chairman reported on the meeting which had taken place earlier that evening. The Annual Village Meeting would commence at 7.30 pm on Thursday 24th May. It was hoped to have presentations by Chester & Warrington Tourist Board, Audlem Medical Practice and Audlem Traders' Association.

<u>163.7 The Old Orchard</u> – Inspection of the site suggested that clearance costs could be prohibitive for the Parish Council.

Resolved: that British Waterways be asked clarify the terms of their proposal.
