10.06 CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON 12TH APRIL

10.07 PARISH AFFAIRS

- <u>07.1 Village policing</u> PC Maple and Mr Graham reported on activities of the local speedwatch group and requested that the Parish Council consider purchasing a speed gun. Councillors agreed to consider this at the next meeting and asked Mr Graham to provide traffic data to support the request. PC Maple reported that he had not yet been able to make progress with refurbishing the Teen Shelter.
- <u>07.2 First Responders & Ambulance response times</u> Cllr Hill reported that NWAS had now provided data in a satisfactory format. He was happy to report that the new Chief Executive of NWAS was listening to criticisms of the service and making improvements. Upgraded training for first responders would be offered by the end of summer.
- <u>07.3 Lengthsman: holiday/sickness cover</u> It was noted that Cheshire East Council would provide cover for holidays and sickness, initially without charge.
- <u>07.4 Cressy Cruise on 4th July</u> The Chairman agreed to represent the Parish Council at the event and hoped for support from colleagues.
- <u>07.5 Public toilets</u> Councillors noted results of the survey conducted on www.audlem.org. It was agreed that Cheshire East should informed again of Parish Council's extreme dissatisfaction at the condition and inadequacy of the facility, also comments of Community Pride judges and the outcome of the website survey.

10.9 HIGHWAYS

- <u>9.1 Parking on Whitchurch Road</u> The Highways Engineer had advised that the Parish Council's needed to ensure inclusion of proposals on the priority list held by Cheshire East. Councillors agreed that a site meeting should take place and that the Co-op should be reminded of its obligation to load/unload at the rear of the premises.
- <u>9.2 Request for dropped kerbs on Stafford Street</u> The Highways Engineer's response (referring to the necessity for full road closure and a sizeable diversion) was noted and it was agreed that a site meeting should be requested.
- <u>9.3 Heathfield Road (hatching etc)</u> Councillors noted that action had not been taken by Highways due to opposition from nearby residents.
- <u>9.4 Condition of pavements</u> Cllr Rowe reported on hazardous sections of pavement in the village centre. The Clerk would draw these to the attention of Highways.
- <u>9.5 A525</u> Cllr Hill advised that local groups were making further efforts to reduce and slow down through traffic. It would be sensible and beneficial for the Parish Council's Highways Committee to work closely with other local interests.
- 10.10 AUDLEM BURIAL COMMITTEE Nothing to report.
- 10.11 <u>AUDLEM PUBLIC HALL</u> Cllr Stretch reported that work on the front walls had started; installation of new heating and lighting systems were being considered.

Cllrs Hill and Consterdine reported on the outcome of early enquiries regarding land for allotments. Cllr Bradbury-Smith reported on a meeting with the new Consultant Headteacher of St James's School, when relocation of the recycling bin, the grit bin and the dog bin had been discussed.
