## **Audlem Parish Council**

**Business Summary, July 2015** 

#### Chairman's Annual Report - July 2015

This has been another busy and challenging year for the Parish Council, dominated by planning matters. The year began with the Gladman Developments Appeal being heard in Crewe during May, and ongoing applications from Hockenhull Developments to build in Heathfield Road. Sadly, early in 2015 Gladman won their Appeal because of the lack of a 5 year housing land supply in Cheshire East, and the Heathfield Road development was then given planning permission for the same reason.

During 2014 it became increasingly obvious that the only possible way to have any influence on planning decisions in the area was to produce a Neighbourhood Plan (NP). At an Extraordinary Parish Council meeting in July 2014 residents gave a resounding vote to develop a Plan for the Parish. Audlem was fortunate to be chosen as part of the 'front-runner' group in Cheshire East which meant that Cheshire East Council provided resource to help draft a Plan with the assistance of their Planning Department and Cheshire Community Action. With the help of a very able and committed group of volunteers this has resulted in our draft NP being ready for formal consultation which ended on 10 June 2015. The Steering Committee is reviewing all the responses received to determine whether to incorporate suggestions into the Plan. It was approved by the Parish Council at its meeting on 13 July and has now been sent to Cheshire East for review and, hopefully, referendum in the not too distant future. The aim is to ensure gradual development in the Parish to allow the infrastructure to develop alongside the increased number of homes.

The proposal to take over the playing field, play area, tennis courts and car park from Cheshire East Council has also posed challenges as a Working Group of Councillors found out what will be involved in managing the complex. A report has been produced for Councillors and a formal submission to take over the area was endorsed at the Council meeting on 13 July. The report can be found on the Parish Council section of Audlem OnLine.

This has also been the year for Parish Council elections. With insufficient candidates standing, those nominated were duly elected without a ballot. Richard Furber retired from the Council with over 25 years of excellent service and John Langston also stood down in May. We would like to thank them both for their contribution to the community. We now welcome new Councillors John Thompson and Ann Tilling and the return of Bill Consterdine who has many years of experience in the role. Thanks are also extended to Phil Johnson, outgoing Chairman and John Kemble, Responsible Financial Officer who resigned after 10 years in the role. Kirstin Dixon, our Clerk, has now taken over responsibility for financial matters. We were saddened by the sudden death of ex-Councillor Irene Stockton who had been a valued member of the Burial Board and instrumental in the remodelling of the children's play area.

We know that the coming year will bring more challenges especially in planning. I would like to thank Councillors for their time and commitment and residents for their support in helping to ensure Audlem remains 'the jewel in the crown of South Cheshire'.

(There is no meeting in August.) At the beginning of each meeting, residents have the opportunity to bring matters of concern to the attention of the Parish Council. Everyone is welcome to stay and listen for the rest of the meeting.

## **Playing Field Complex**

At their July meeting, Parish Councillors agreed to submit a formal request to Cheshire East Council for the transfer of the playing field, car park, tennis courts and play area to the Parish Council to go ahead. The request includes the formal submission, a separate report which was produced for Councillors and was accepted at the June meeting, and an outline of the costs that would be incurred as a result of the transfer. The matter is now in the hands of Cheshire East Council and it is hoped that the recommendation of their Finance Committee on 13 April 2015 that 'these assets will be prioritised for approval to transfer'. Cheshire East has already agreed the transfer of the land to the rear of the Public Hall to the Public Hall Trustees so they can build their new Annexe.

The cost to the Parish Council of running this area is between  $\pounds 10,000 - \pounds 14,000$  p.a. It is inevitable that the Parish Precept will need to increase so proper provision can be made for repairs and replacement of capital items such as play equipment. Other means of generating revenue will have to be investigated including charging for use of certain facilities. The Parish Council will investigate setting up a charitable Trust which would minimise the cost to the community and intends to try to obtain grants for some of the equipment replacement where available.
