Parish Council News, July 2016

Playing Field, Car Park and Children's Play Area

Parish Councillors were dismayed to learn Cheshire East Council is reviewing its policy on transferring assets to Town and Parish Councils. Instead of the Playing Field complex being permanently transferred to the Parish Council (as with the public toilets) playing fields may now only be transferred on a 30 year lease. This is apparently in order to protect recreational areas from development in perpetuity.

Councillors are concerned that residents would be liable for expensive maintenance which would require a higher local precept on an asset on which there would be no continuity of ownership. It would also be difficult to get grants towards costs on a relatively short lease. Additionally, there would be no reduction in council tax.

Councillors recently met with representatives of Cheshire East Council to discuss their concerns. At the time of writing there is no definite news on whether the proposed change of policy has been adopted.

Hedges

It would be really appreciated if residents who have hedges or trees alongside pavements and paths could keep them trimmed. This will allow easier pedestrian access, especially for those in wheelchairs or buggies.



Update on Recent Planning Applications

Little Heath (120 dwellings) The Parish Council has sent a report indicating where the 'reserved matters' proposal conflicts with the Audlem Neighbourhood Plan, and the Village Design Statement, and what modifications it would like to see. We are still awaiting a response from Cheshire East Council.

Mill Lane (2 dwellings) This application was originally refused by CEC, but has now gone to appeal. The Parish Council has submitted its case against the appellant's case. (See Mill Lane bridleway below.)



Heathfield Road (26 dwellings) Outline planning permission has been granted by CEC. We are still awaiting details of the design.

Bird's Nest – opposite the Little Heath development above (20 dwellings) The PC has submitted an objection to this application.

Moorsfield Avenue (87 dwellings) Audlem PC has objected strongly. No decision has been taken by CEC on this application.

Parish Council meetings will be held in the Meeting Rooms adjoining Audlem Methodist Church on Mondays, 5 September, 3 October. (There is no meeting in August.) At the beginning of each meeting, residents have the opportunity to bring matters of concern to the attention of the Parish Council. Everyone is welcome to stay and listen for the rest of the meeting.

Parish Paths

Residents who attended the Village Meeting in March 2016 will be aware that on 1 January 2026 any footpaths and bridleways that existed on 1 January 1949 but are not yet on the definitive map held by Cheshire East Council will be 'extinguished' and no longer be considered rights of way.

Whilst the cut-off date may seem a long way off, it is important that we can be sure that all our footpaths are identified and logged with the local authority to ensure that the paths remain open for future use. This is especially so for those shown on the OS maps as 'other routes with public access' (ORPS), routes straddling local authority boundaries and any other anomalies. Whilst we are confident that the main paths up to the Shropshire border are recorded, when they reach the county boundary there are no footpath signs and the path is often overgrown and inaccessible to walkers. One keen walker has already raised the issue of a path from Adderley to Cox Bank which has been removed from the rights of way map by Shropshire Council, and representations have been made by the Ramblers Association and Audlem Parish Council to get the path reinstated before 2026.

Additionally, there are many little walkways used around the Parish which may not be on the definitive paths map, or a regularly used 'ginnel' may have a small gap between the path and the road which could potentially be closed off if not identified over the next 10 years. Unfortunately, the definitive paths map cannot be viewed on line: it involves a trip to the Council offices to inspect it.

The Parish Council and Audlem Ramblers Association are proposing to set up a small working group to look into this matter and would welcome hearing from any resident who would like to get involved in this project.

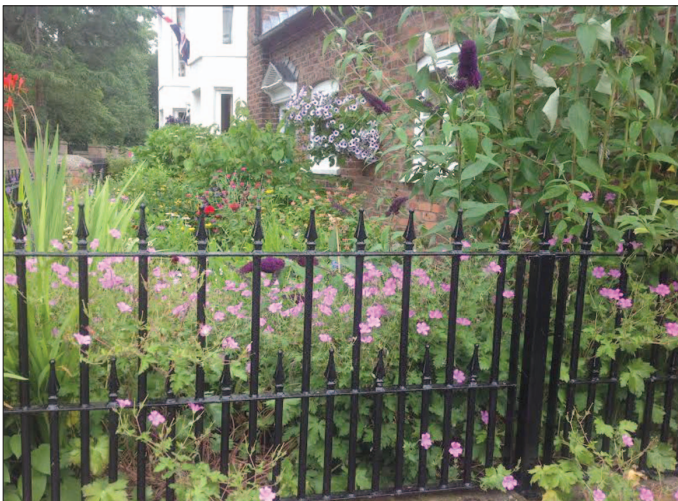
ADAS News

APHAx (Audlem Public Hall Annexe) Update

These are exciting times for the APHax team as we approach the construction stage of the annexe to Audlem Public Hall. Since confirmation of the Big Lottery Funding a vast amount of necessary detail has been dealt with and we will be keeping the village informed of what is happening. The key points are:

- Tenders have been invited from a number of suitably experienced builders.
- It is expected that the successful one will be confirmed late July/early August with work starting on site end of August 2016 with completion June 2017.
- The first action will be the builder establishing his site compound, which will of necessity be larger than the new building.
- The plan showing the extent of this cannot be published here for technical reasons, but displays of the map will appear on Audlem Online, the village information screens and other prominent places soon.
- It will require temporary changes in the car parking which will be re-lined with the aim of minimising any loss of spaces. Cheshire East, the landowner, has granted APHax a licence for the compound to be erected.
- The builders have been advised to use the compound for work force vehicles and make every effort to park off site.
- The degree of disruption will be kept to a minimum. Access to the playing field, playground, tennis courts and Public Hall will not be affected.
- Obviously at times there will be large plant working and construction materials being delivered and APHax will give advance information when this is planned.
- Inevitably a construction project of this size will cause some disruption and we ask for your patience and remember the superb sport and recreational facilities for residents of all ages this will provide.
- The Architect, Martin Bower of Bower Edleston will be Project Manager.
