- 1. Public Forum: Three MOPs attended the meeting.
- 2. Apologies: Apologies were received from Adrian Leighton (AL), Geoff Seddon(GS), & Peter Morgan(PM)
- 3. Notes of the meeting held on 5th June 2023: All members agreed that these were an accurate record.
- 4. **Retrospective Planning Application:** APC have appointed a planning consultant who has submitted a summary of the situation to Cheshire East Council. A formal application for change of use will hopefully be submitted by the 7th July.
- 5. Fields in Trust: The Deed of Dedication remains to be registered with Land Registry.
- 6. Notices & Emergency Contacts: These are in place in the majority of locations. Details need to be put on the notice board.(SE)
- 7. Bridge Between Fields: There has been no active response from Canal & Rivers Trust .(SE)
- 8. Shropshire Street Entrance: MOT has been deposited to enhance the entrance.

- 10. .Car Park: Nothing further to report.

11. Maintenance: The Maintenance Plan Summer 23 was discussed and updated. It was agreed that this plan be reviewed monthly. **(JS)**

A further paper "Maintenance Issues to be discussed at TFGW 3rd July" addressing Ragwort Removal, the planned removal of Himalayan Balsam. and the sowing of a small area of wild flower seed were also discussed and approved.

A letter in response to a MOP email on the use of glyphosate had been drafted and it was agreed that this should be sent(**JS**).

- 12. **Trees:** Tree Inspection five firms have been asked to quote for this work, to date, only one response has been received.**GS**)
- **13. Environmental Update:** A report by AL was presented to the meeting, noting that two varieties of orchid have now been seen in the field indicating that the natural mycellial structure of the soil is improving. Cheshire East Council had requested access to the field to carry out a Greater Crested New survey in relation to their road works in Green Lane; this was approved. Noted that three safaris with Guides, Cubs and brownies had been postponed as a result of the impending planning application
- **14. Benches:** The one bench near the Shropshire Street entrance has been removed for repairs. The ADAS Bench is awaited but it was agreed to defer this until the outcome of the planning application is known.
